- i Candidates shall apply online only by One Time Registration to www.keralapsc.gov.in. Applications submitted in any other manner will be summarily rejected.
 - ii Separate Ranked Lists will be prepared for each districts in pursuance of this notification. The Ranked list thus prepared and published by the Commission, shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year, subject to the condition that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised for appointment against the vacancies those are reported during the currency of the list. In case no candidate is advised from the Ranked List till the expiry of the period of three years, the duration of the Ranked List shall be extended for a further period of one year or till at least one candidate is advised from the list, whichever is earlier.
 - iii Candidates should submit the application for this post to any one of the district only. Applications should not be submitted to more than one district in response to this notification. If applications are sent in violation to the above direction and if the candidate is selected, his/ her name will be removed from the Ranked List and disciplinary action will be taken against him/ her.
 - iv The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in GO(MS) No 154/71/PD dated 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he or she completes 5 years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in GO(MS)No 4/61/PD dated 02.01.1961. Candidates already in Government service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.



- v 4% of the total vacancies reported for the above post shall be reserved for eligible Differently Abled candidates with disabilities as specified vide GO(P)No 5/2023/SJD dated 01.10.2023.

5. **Method of appointment** : Direct Recruitment
6. **Age Limit** : 18-40. Only Candidates born between 02.01.1984 and 01.01.2006 (Both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post with usual relaxation to SC/ST and Other Backward Classes.

Note: For concessions allowed in upper age limit subject to the condition that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 (fifty) years of age, please see Para 2 of the General Conditions under Part II of this notification.

7. **Qualifications:**

- 1 A Bachelors Degree with Mathematics or Statistics as Main Subject and BED/ BT in the concerned subjects conferred or recognized by the Universities in Kerala.

- 2 Must have passed the Kerala Teacher Eligibility Test (K-TET Category III) for this post conducted by the Government of Kerala.

Exemption:

- i Candidates who have qualified C-TET/ NET/ SET/ MPhil/ PhD in the respective subjects/ MEd in any subject are exempted from acquiring K-TET [GO(P)No 145/16/GEEdn dated 30.08.2016, GO(P)No 206/16/GEEdn dated 08.12.2016 and GO(P)No 15/2020/GEEdn dated 09.10.2020].

- ii C-TET (Primary stage and Elementary stage) qualification shall not be considered as an alternative qualification for K-TET Category III [GO(P)No 6/2024/ GEEdn dated 01.02.2024].

Note: i MPhil in the concerned subject be the one awarded by any of the Universities in Kerala or recognised as equivalent by any of the Universities in Kerala.

- ii Post Graduates in Mathematics/ Statistics with BED/ BT in the subject concerned will also be considered for this post.

- iii Diploma in Rural Service awarded by the National Council for Rural Higher Education will also be treated as equivalent to Degree for the above purpose.

- iv The candidates who have acquired BScEd in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics stream conducted by the Regional Institute of Education, Mysore of NCERT are also eligible to apply for the post [GO(P)No 117/13/GEEd dated 30.03.2013].

- v The disciplines in which BSc/ MSc and BED/ BT Degree were obtained should be mentioned in the application.

- vi If there is Written (Descriptive/ OMR) test, the Question paper for the Written test will be in Malayalam. The candidates should answer the questions in Malayalam. In the case of OMR Answer Script, answers are to be marked as instructed.

- vii Rule 10(a) ii of part II of KS&SSR is applicable for this post.

- viii In addition to the qualifications prescribed in this notification, the qualifications recognized by Executive/ Standing Orders of Government as equivalent to the qualifications specified for a post, in the Special Rules and such of those qualifications which pre-suppose the acquisition of the lower qualification prescribed for the post, shall also be sufficient for the post. The copy of Government Orders declaring equivalent/ higher qualifications shall be produced as and when called for by the Commission.



8 SPECIAL CONCESSIONS REGARDING APPOINTMENT AND AGE LIMIT:

- i Preference will be given as laid down in GO(MS)No 50/70/PD dated 12.02.1970 and GO(MS) No9/78/GEdn dated 21.01.1978 to the wives of Jawans in the matter of recruitment as Teachers, if they possess the prescribed qualifications. Soldiers in active service and those working in Base Establishment are included under the term 'Jawans'. Such candidates should obtain proper certificates from the Commanding Officer stating the Name, Military rank and Military address of their husbands and produce the same as and when required by the Commission [GO(MS)No. 509/64/Edn dated 19.09.1964, GO(MS)No 614/65/Edn dated 09.11.1965 and GO(MS)No 243/66/Edn dated 27.05.1966].
- ii First Class Scouts and Guides will be given preference in the matter of appointment as Teachers [GO(MS)No 122/75/GEdn dated 27.05.1975 and GO(MS)No 50/70/PD dated 12/02/1970].
- iii Laboratory Attenders in the Departmental High Schools in the State who have rendered at least 5 years satisfactory service and who possess the prescribed qualification will be exempted from age limit. They should produce proper certificates from the headmaster of the school specifying the date of commencement of their service and the total service put in by them as and when required by the Commission. The candidates who claim exemption on this will be considered only against vacancies to be filled up by open competition on the basis of merit alone [GO(MS)No 315/62/Edn dated 14.05.1962].
- iv Teachers of the Government Primary and Nursery Schools who are graduates and are otherwise qualified will be exempted from upper age limit [GO(MS)No 185/70/Edn dated 18.4.1970 and GO(MS)No 466/70/Edn dated 11.11.1970]. They should produce proper certificates from authorities concerned as and when required by the Commission.

Note: The candidates who are eligible for the above preference or concessions in upper age limit or concessions by virtue of any of the reason mentioned in para 2 of the General Conditions should claim the same through the “weightage and preferences” link provided in their One Time Registration Profile and give details in the space provided. The applications of candidates who are eligible for concession in upper age limit and who do not claim the same, are liable to be rejected presuming that they are over aged candidates. Upper age limit after allowing the relaxation as per rule should not exceed 50 years of age (See Para 2 of General Conditions).

9. Mode of Sending Application:

- a **Candidates must register as per “ ONE TIME REGISTRATION” with the Official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission 'www.keralapsc.gov.in' before applying for the post.** Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on to their profile using their user ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. **Candidates who are creating profile newly, should upload the photograph taken within 6 months.** Name of the candidate and the date of photograph taken should be printed legibly at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of taking of the photograph. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the profile, candidates must ensure correctness of the information in their profile. They must quote the User ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. **Candidates are advised to keep a printout or soft copy of the online application for future reference. Candidates can take the printout of the application by clicking on the link 'My applications' in their profile. All correspondences with the Commission, regarding the application should be accompanied with the print out of the application.** Application will be summarily rejected if non-compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Original documents to prove qualification, community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for.
- b **Candidates who have AADHAAR card should add AADHAAR card as ID Proof in their profile.**

12. If Written/ OMR/ Online Test is conducted as part of this selection, candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration profile. Such



candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days till the date of Test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period, will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission Tickets will be published in the Examination Programme itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phone numbers registered in it.

13. Special Instructions to Candidates :

- i In the case of difference in Caste/ Community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC Book, the candidate shall produce a gazette notification in this regard, along with Non-Creamy Layer Certificate/ Community Certificate at the time of Certificate Verification.
- ii Candidates are required to acquaint themselves with the instructions given in the notification as Part II, General Conditions before submitting application for the post. Applications which are not submitted in accordance with the terms and conditions laid down in the General Conditions are liable to be rejected.
- iii Appropriate disciplinary action as per Rule 22 of the Kerala Public Service Commission Rules of Procedure 1976, shall be initiated against those candidates who submit applications with bogus claims of qualification regarding education, experience etc. and are liable to be disqualified for being considered for a particular post or debarment from applying to the Commission either permanently or for any period or the invalidation of their answer scripts or products in a Written/ Practical test or the initiation of criminal or other proceedings against them or their removal or dismissal from office or the ordering of any other disciplinary action against them if they have already been appointed, or any one or more of the above.
